

Use of the Podium

Guidelines Governing the Use of the Podium at a Cincinnati Ski Club (CSC) General Membership Meetings:

Adopted November 1999

As stated in our by-laws, the President, or a Board Officer appointed by the President, will open and preside over each General membership meeting. This is an official club meeting and time at the podium should be limited to discussing or communicating club business.

Permission to use the podium at an official club meeting will be guided by the following criteria:

- 1) You must be a member in good standing in the CSC.
- 2) You must be acting as a representative of a CSC activity or interest.
- 3) You may not promote or solicit businesses or services that are not affiliated with or sanctioned by the CSC.
- 4) Any announcements promoting Charities or special interests (not adopted by the CSC) or announcements containing political or religious views, may be found offensive to some and are therefore not permitted.

The President (or appointed Officer presiding over a club meeting) has the responsibility and authority to decide at the meeting which announcements will be permitted.
