

Policy for Ticketed Events

Adopted July 2002

General:

The intent is that CSC Events will be budgeted to include a Trip Leader Reward and any relevant CSC fees (like the Reserve fee). However, the nature of some Events may make adding these budget items seem inappropriate. Such Events, by a Motion approved by the CSC Board, may be established as a "Ticketed Event" and, therefore, exclude those budget items.

Guidelines:

Events that may qualify for "Ticketed Event" status will generally have the following characteristics:

- 1) The cost of the Event is primarily a "ticket" that can generally be bought by the public for essentially the same price.
- 2) The activities & responsibilities of the Trip Leader are primarily to collect names/money and buy/distribute the tickets. They do not have any responsibilities for activities such as travel coordination, parties, etc. Additionally, the TL's financial accounting to the CSC consists solely of deposits, a roster & a simple "count" of the # of tickets bought/sold. There are no "extra" TL expenses and/or Event expenses beyond the ticket cost.
- 3) The Event offers little, or no, "at risk \$'s" to the CSC
